and do my work.**



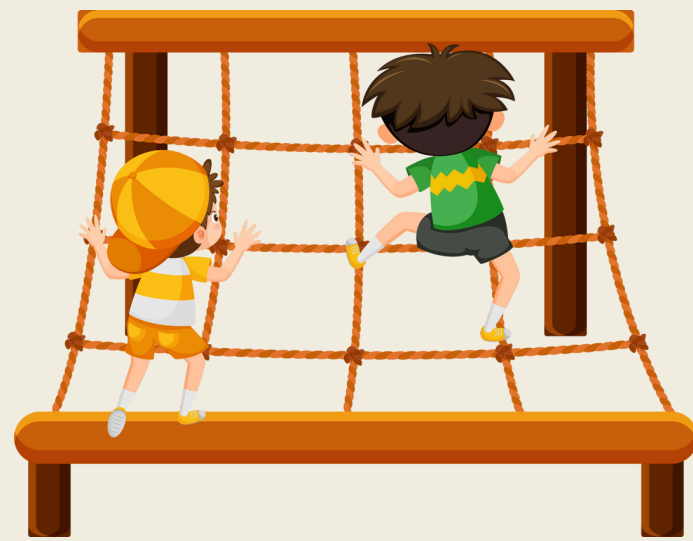


When it's time for circle time, I get up and walk to the circle area. I sit with my friends and listen to the teacher. I might share my ideas or listen to others.



When it's time for recess, I put on my "ready to play power." This helps me have fun and be a good friend.

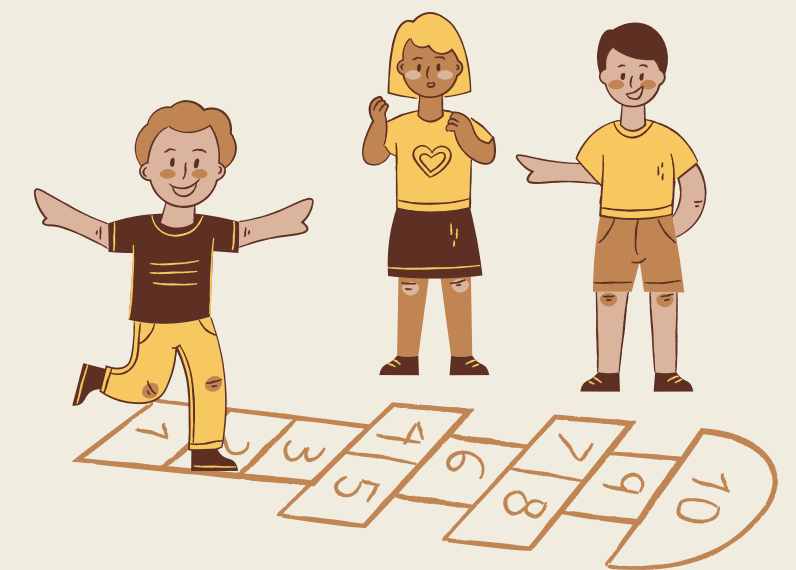




Playing with Friends
